1. The date and time of the entrance examination 28.09.2025 (Sunday), morning session during: 10.00 a.m to 12.00 p.m. Reporting time 9.00 a.m. Afternoon session during 2.00 p.m to 4.00 p.m. Reporting time 1.00 p.m.
2. No candidate without a valid Hall Ticket shall be allowed to enter the Examination Hall.
3. If your photo is not available on the Hall Ticket or if your photo is not clear, please bring your recent passport size photo with a valid photo Id proof that Aadhar Card, Driving Licence, Voter ID Card, Passport), to the examination hall.
4. **Candidates are informed that they are PROVISIONALLY admitted to this Entrance Exam. The permission to appear for the Entrance Exam is only an enabling provision. The decision on the eligibility of the candidate for admission to a course entirely rests with the University, after verification of original certificates.**
5. No candidate shall be allowed to enter the Examination Hall 30 minutes after the commencement of the Examination and shall not be permitted to leave the Examination Hall before the completion of Examination Time.
6. Use of log tables, wrist watches, electronic gadgets / communication devices like cellular/mobile phone, Bluetooth, microphones, earphone, etc. are not allowed in the Examination Hall.
7. Candidates are required to bring only a blue/ black pen.

8. Candidates with disabilities (40% and above) will be permitted to engage the services of scribe and avail extra time as per GOI norms. The scribe will be provided by the University, the qualification of the scribe should be one step below the qualification of the candidate taking examination.
9. Candidates are advised to retain this Hall Ticket to produce it at the time of Admission.
10. Candidates are requested to see University website www.pondiuni.edu.in periodically, for latest information and updates.

11. INSTRUCTION TO CANDIDATES FOR FILLING OF OMR SHEET

- a) Only use a blue or black ball point pen to fill in the circles.
- b) No rough work shall be done on the OMR sheet.
- c) Once a circle is filled, it cannot be erased or changed.

QUESTION PAPER PATTERN

1. Write your Register Number within the box provided on the top of this page and fill in the page 1 of the answer sheet using pen.
2. Do not write your name anywhere in this booklet or answer sheet. Violation of this entails disqualification.
3. Read each question carefully and shade the relevant answer (A) or (B) or (C) or (D) in the relevant box of the ANSWER SHEET using Pen.
4. Avoid blind guessing. A wrong answer will fetch you –1 mark and the correct answer will fetch 4 marks.
5. Do not write anything in the question paper. Use the white sheets attached at the end for rough works.
6. Do not open the question paper until the start signal is given.
7. Do not attempt to answer after stop signal is given. Any such attempt will disqualify your candidature.
8. On stop signal, keep the question paper and the answer sheet on your table and wait for the invigilator to collect them.

CANDIDATE CAN BE DEBARRED /DISQUALIFIED BY THE CENTER-IN-CHARGE FOR ANY OF THE FOLLOWING REASONS:

- Creating a disturbance.
- Impersonate – Attempting to take the examination for someone else.
- Giving or receiving assistance of any kind during the examination & communication in any form between candidates or with outsiders or gesticulation or disturbance or attempt to change seat / question paper in the examination hall
- Attempting to tamper with the OMR Sheet.
- Leaving the test center without the permission from the invigilator.
- Using prohibited aids, item not allowed, such as: Cell Phones, Pieces of Paper, Electronic Diaries, Watch alarm, listening device, recording or photographic devices, or any other unauthorized device.
- Attempting to remove examination question and /or examination responses (in any format) from the examination center.
- Falling to follow instructions of invigilator or test center staff.
- Manhandling of invigilators or test center staff.
- Resorting to unfair means or trying to influence any person duly authorized to conduct the examination, in any way for examination results shall be considered as a serious offence.
