(I) Wherever relevant to any specific discipline, the API score for papers in refereed journal would be augmented as follows: (i) papers with impact factor less than 1 by 5 points; (ii) papers with impact factor between than 1 and 2 by 10 points; (iii) papers with impact factor between than 2 and 5 by 15; papers with impact factor between than 5 and 10 by 20 points; papers with impact factor above 20 by 25 points.

(II) The API for Joint Publications shall be calculated in the following manner: of the total score for the relevant category of publications by the concerned teacher, the first and principal/corresponding author/supervisor/mentor would share equally 70 % of the total points and the remaining 30% would be shared equally by all other authors.

(III) * The University shall identify the journals subject-wise through subject expert committees and forward the recommendations to UGC in the format prescribed by UGC for approval of the UGC Standing Committee. The journals approved from this list, by the UGC Standing Committee, shall be included in the “List of Journals” notified by the UGC. The UGC Standing Committee shall give its recommendations within 60 working days of the receipt of the list from the University. The UGC Standing Committee may also, suo-moto, recommend journals for inclusion in the “List of Journals”. The subject-wise list of journals, periodicals and publishers under categories IIIA and B that are hosted in the University website (www.pondiuni.edu.in/content/list-journals-if), would be used as guidelines by the scrutinizing committee for scrutinizing purpose. However, the scrutinizing committee reserves the right to decide on the qualifying journal/publisher for the purpose of finalizing the API score for the purpose of scrutinizing.
