Preamble

Creation and dissemination of knowledge through research is one of the core functions of the higher learning institutions. Apart from generating new knowledge, the higher learning institutions, particularly the universities have the responsibility to train the intellectual manpower required for all sectors of the society. Anveshan: Student Research convention aims at identifying young and rising talents who would be promoted through proper encouragement and incentives. The endeavor is expected to accelerate scientific research and innovation and their application towards societal development percolating to the grass root level. Initiated in 2007 Anveshan has been applauded across the country for providing an innovative platform to students and generating a great deal of enthusiasm among the young and emerging breed of researchers in the country, Nevertheless, the initiative is an attempt to inculcate and strengthen a culture of research in the universities and other institutions of Higher Learning.

Objectives

- To identify young talents with research aptitude and interest to take up research as career option.
- To promote the talent in research throughout the country.
- To nurture the talent through specialized training and education in some of the nationally and internationally reputed premier institutions of higher learning in the country.
- To augment financial and physical resources through collaboration with different sponsors for supporting education and training of the young researchers.
- To provide proper incentives to enhance the skill of potential students.
- To initiate an intensive research culture in a selected group of institutions.

About Anveshan

With a view to inculcating research culture in our higher education institutions, the Research Division of Association of Indian Universities has taken a pioneering initiative to organize Student Research Conventions for the aspiring researchers throughout the country. These Conventions aim at identifying the young and rising talents who would be promoted through proper encouragement and incentives. Also an attempt shall be made to commercialize their research projects with industrial collaboration. Aimed at identifying and nurturing research talent of the young and budding researchers in the country, the Anveshan is guided by two principal objectives: firstly, to identify young researchers with research aptitude and interest and to motivate and support them for taking up research as a career option; secondly to identify fresh talents with unconventional and innovative ideas and channelize them into research that would contribute to creating a solid core of knowledge workers and simultaneously solving the day to day problems by finding dynamic and possible solutions.

Research Areas / Fields

The areas / fields in which Projects (Individual and Group Projects*) are invited:

- AGRICULTURE
- BASIC SCIENCES
- ENGINEERING & TECHNOLOGY
- HEALTH SCIENCES AND ALLIED SUBJECTS, PHARMACY, NUTRITION. ETC.
- SOCIAL SCIENCES, HUMANITIES, COMMERCE AND LAW (OBJECTIVE AND RESULT ORIENTED PROJECTS)

*In case of a Group project, only three members [one principal investigator and two major contributors] are allowed to participate in the zonal/national convention.

Structure / Nature of the Project

Projects on the above mentioned areas must be original and must have undergone some exploration / ground work in order to show their feasibility and impact.

The conventions will be held in three phases

- i. In the First Phase, all universities in the country will be requested to organize an exhibition of research projects at University level in which students from Affiliated/Constituent Colleges, Research Institutions and University Postgraduate Departments will be invited to participate. The exhibited projects will be scrutinized by a team of experts of their respective areas.
- ii. In the Second Phase, the exhibition will be held at Zonal level for which Five Universities, one in each zone, have been identified (calendar enclosed for details in www.aiuweb.org.). From each zone best 15 projects will be given entry to compete at the National level.
- iii. In the Third Phase, the exhibition/competition will be held at National level. The Association of Indian Universities will call for the successful projects, selected through the zonal competition, for National level competition.

A total of 75 selected projects (from five zones, each zone 15 best projects, three in each category) will be presented for assessment at the National Level, out of which, 15 projects will be finally selected for awards.

Number of Projects to be selected

- Each university is allowed to send a maximum FIVE projects for the zonal level Student Research Convention preferably one each from each category. In case of the universities/ institutes not having courses/ programmes in all the above mentioned categories, entry of five projects in their respective fields shall also be entertained. For example, agricultural universities may send five projects from agriculture category itself.
- The selected projects duly countersigned by the Head of the

Organization must reach the coordinator of the host university in each ZONE by the stipulated date i.e., **January 10, 2018.** Registration form for zonal level convention is enclosed.

Method of Assessment

- The projects are assessed by a panel of experts drawn from various disciplines on the basis of criteria laid down for assessment.
- The projects can be presented in the form of live demonstrations/models/poster/podium(oral) presentation.
- Assessment of projects is done in three rounds each at Zonal and National Level. In the first round the contestants have to display their projects in poster presentations (size of poster 1mx1m). If selected in the first round, the projects will be allowed for the second round where the contestants have to make a podium (oral) presentation before the panel of judges. In the third round, the presentation will be open for Question-Answer.
- Total time allowed for podium (oral) presentation and question-answer is 10 minutes, seven minutes for presentation and three minutes for Question answer.

Assessment Criteria and Weightage

The final selection of projects is based on the cumulative weightage given on all the criteria.

•	Scientific Thoughts and Principles	20
•	Creativity	20
•	Thoroughness	10
•	Skill	10
•	Relevance	20
•	Cost Effectiveness	10
•	Teamwork	10

Apart from the above criteria, Scope of Commercialization of the projects will be considered as an additional merit. However, there will be no weightage point for this criterion. In case of the projects having scored equal cumulative weightage point, this criterion will be considered for making the final decision. In case of Individual Projects, the assessment will be made by including the weightage point 10 assigned for team work.

Eligibility for Participation

Entries of the research projects will be purely institutional and only bonafide fulltime students/research scholars from undergraduate to doctoral degree level are eligible to take part in the convention. Those who are below 30 years of age are only eligible to take part in the convention. Certificates will be issued to the participants and mementoes will be issued to the winners.

How to Register?

Those students who are shortlisted in the first phase (at University Level) will be given entry to the zonal level convention.
